

### **DESCRIPTION**




Figure 1. Output Voltage vs Output Current

A Dynamic Output Control (DOC<sup>TM</sup>) circuit is implemented, which, during the transition, initially lowers the output impedance to effectively drive the load and, subsequently, raises the impedance to reduce noise. Figure 1 shows typical  $V_{OL}$  vs  $I_{OL}$  and  $V_{OH}$  vs  $I_{OH}$  curves to illustrate the output impedance and drive capability of the circuit. At the beginning of the signal transition, the DOC circuit provides a maximum dynamic drive that is equivalent to a high-drive standard-output device. This 16-bit universal bus driver is operational at 1.2-V to 3.6-V  $V_{CC}$ , but is designed specifically for 1.65-V to 3.6-V  $V_{CC}$  operation.

Data flow from A to Y is controlled by the output-enable  $(\overline{OE})$  input. The device operates in the transparent mode when the latch-enable  $(\overline{LE})$  input is low. When  $\overline{LE}$  is high, the A data is latched if the clock (CLK) input is held at a high or low logic level. If  $\overline{LE}$  is high, the A data is stored in the latch/flip-flop on the low-to-high transition of CLK. When  $\overline{OE}$  is high, the outputs are in the high-impedance state.

To ensure the high-impedance state during power up or power down,  $\overline{OE}$  should be tied to  $V_{CC}$  through a pullup resistor; the minimum value of the resistor is determined by the current-sinking capability of the driver.

This device is fully specified for partial-power-down applications using  $I_{off}$ . The  $I_{off}$  circuitry disables the outputs, preventing damaging current backflow through the device when it is powered down.













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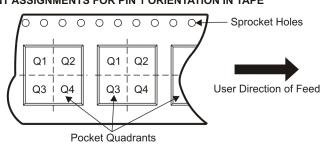
